TITLE: (suggested title in DeltaCad) "Mark Circle Centers"

## **DESCRIPTION:**

This macro sequentially finds the center of each circle in the drawing, reports the center coordinates, and marks the center with a temporary point entity.

Circle centers are found even if the layer carrying the circle is turned off. The center points are always drawn in the current layer.

(Note: This macro was more useful before DeltaCad Version 5 added the <Parallel Circle> option to the Circle Toolbar.)

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:**

- 1) Add this file to your Macro list as "Mark Circle Centers"
- 2) Select "Mark Circle Centers" from the Macro list. Click on <Run Macro> on the Macro Toolbar to use it.
- 3) When it locates a circle click "OK" in the pop-up dialogue box to mark it's center.

## NOTE:

The drawing this Macro is to be used on must have circle(s) on it for it to find the center(s). It does not locate ellipse centers.
